Home Talk

Who is it for?

- For children aged between 2 years and 2 years 6 months
- Children with delayed spoken language development
- Not intended for children with difficulties in other areas of speech, language and communication
- Read our Home Talk Factsheet for more details

What does it involve?

- Up to 6 home visits from an experienced and friendly Home Talk Worker
- Sharing ideas and strategies through fun activities to help children's spoken language
- A visit 3 months later to review the child's progress
- The Home Talk Worker will link with the child's setting/nursery (with parent/carer permission)
